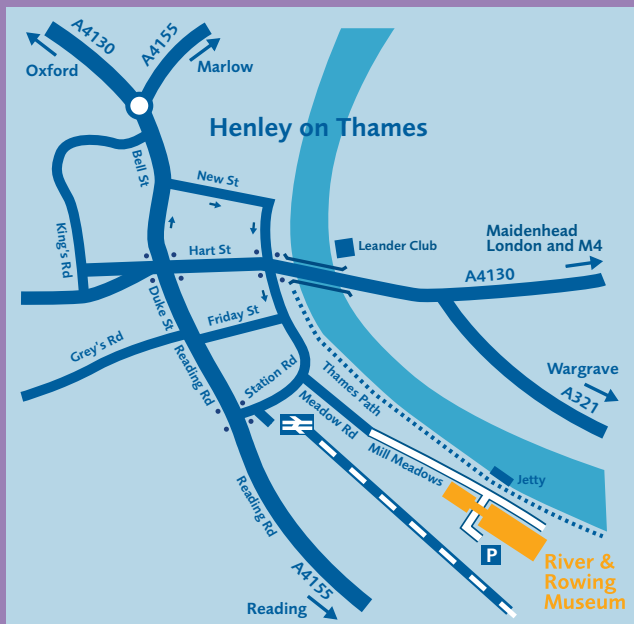


Where to find us
